The are equipped with a digital recorder, monitor, four low-light day/night cameras, two way audio and air card for internet transmission. Each MSU is powered by solar panels and batteries. It also has an inverter to convert power and a backup generator. Because the units use cellular transmission and web-based technology, we can monitor anywhere at a reasonable cost adds Fredy Ramsoondar, the Company’s Chief Financial Officer.”
